Mr. Jesus M. Olivares, city staff and Laredo brokers are in attendance at the 2016 Mexico Auto Manufacturer's conference in Leon, Guanajuato. City Manager and staff have met with all major auto manufacturers to continue promoting Port Laredo. During discussions, city staff continued promoting the importance of Port Laredo, ongoing projects such as the Federal Inspection Facilities at the Laredo International Airport where for the first time in U.S. history Mexican Customs (SAT) and Customs & Border Protection officials work together to pre-clear Mexico bound air cargo.

Also, promoted for Port Laredo are the on going toll equipment upgrades for the Laredo Bridge System and major upcoming projects such as the additional fast lanes and bridge lanes to be constructed at the World Trade Bridge. Additional discussions were the proposed lane expansions on Loop 20 leading to Interstate Highway 35 from World Trade Bridge.
